
SCHOOL LEADERSHIP

A Tri-Pillar Model of School Leadership

Trillium Waldorf School, as a not-for-profit charitable organization, operates with the assistance of a Board of Directors that has the responsibility for the overall financial viability/sustainability of the organization and has fiduciary responsibilities for sound policies and procedures that guide day-to-day operations. The school uses a consensus model approach to decision making with staff/faculty responsible for day-to-day operations and curriculum provision.

The school uses a Tri-pillar model: (i) board/administration, (ii) faculty and (iii) parents; each pillar is involved in decision making at different levels within the overall governance structure of the school.

2nd Contact - PC
